### ⌋ Tobramycin

- Useful tool in assist in vitreous surgery including safe ILM peeling.
- Effective In reducing subclinical conjunctival inflammation before filter in surgery.
- Proves to be a safe anti-inflammatory treatment of avoiding steroid-induced glaucoma.

### ⌋ Loteprednol Etabonate

- Relieving Symptoms such as swelling, redness and itching
- A corticosteroid for the treatment of post-operative inflammation and pain following ocular surgery

### ⌋ Benzalkonium Chloride

- Improves ear pressure in otitis media
