## Tranexamic Acid

- First line treatment for idiopathic menorrhagia in combination with Mefenamic Acid.
- More effective at reducing menstrual blood loss than Flurbiprofen, Ethamsylate and Norethisterone.
- Eight times more potent in terms of binding to plasminogen/plasmin than the other synthetic anti-fibrinolytic agent E-aminocaproic acid.

## Mefenamic Acid

- Eliminate risk of venous thromboembolism associated with the use of tranexamic acid.
- Effective for patients with menorrhagia associated with adenomyosis or intrauterine contraceptive devices (IUCD's).
