Esomeprazole

- Esomeprazole is a Proton Pump Inhibitor.
- Fast onset of action gives fast relief.

Levosulpiride

- The new prokinetic agent, demonstrates greater central anti-dopaminergic activity, antisemitic and antidiabetic effects.
- Provides better relief from overall symptoms thus ensures better quality of life to patients.

Amoxicillin

- Amoxicillin is a penicillin antibiotic that fights bacteria
- Used in combination with other medications to eliminate H. pylori, a bacteria that causes ulcers.

Clarithromycin

- It is a macrolide antibiotic used for the treatment of a wide variety of bacterial infections

Domperidone

- Increases the movements or contractions of the stomach and bowel
- Used to treat nausea and vomiting
